Mae ymddygiad gwrthgymdeithasol ar hyd arfordir Caerdydd a'r Fro wedi mwy na haneru dros y ddwy flynedd ddiwethaf.

Mae'r gostyngiad i'w weld er gwaetha'r ffaith fod nifer yr ymwelwyr â'n harfordir wedi dychwelyd i lefelau cyn y pandemig yn ystod yr haf eleni.

Rhwng mis Gorffennaf a mis Medi, gwnaeth nifer y digwyddiadau y rhoddwyd gwybod amdanynt ostwng 43% o 2020 i 2021 a 12% pellach yn 2022.

Mae hyn yn deillio o waith Ymgyrch Elstree, sef ymgyrch amlasantathol sydd â'r nod o gadw ardaloedd arfordirol yn ddiogel a sicrhau eu bod yn ystyriol o deuluoedd.

Anti-social behaviour along the Cardiff & Vale coastline has more than halved in the last two years.

This reduction is despite the number of visitors to the our coast returning to pre-pandemic levels this summer.

Between the period July and September, reported incidents reduced by 43% from 2020 to 2021 and by a further 12% in 2022.

This is the result of Operation Elstree – a multi-agency operation aimed at keeping coastal areas safe and family-friendly.

Together with, British Transport Police, Welsh Ambulance Service, RNLI, South Wales Fire & Rescue, local authorities and businesses, here are some ways #OpElstree has kept you safe:

- Extra patrols on foot, horse, quad bike and by boat.
- Section 35 notices to move people on.
- CCTV van in key locations.
- Safety bands to reunite missing children.
- Fines for illegal parking.
- Joint educational events
